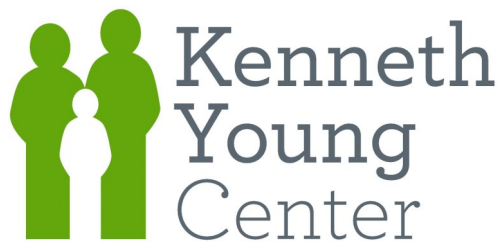

- Alcohol, drug, and pregnancy prevention services to schools, community groups, and awareness coalitions
